Tri-Valley Haven hosts Self-Defense Workshops for women and teens quarterly at Las Positas College. Tri-Valley Haven's self-defense training is based on the Women's Empowerment Model of Self Defense. In each 3-hour class, the instructor will cover awareness, assertiveness, boundary setting and concrete physical techniques with participants. There are also opportunities to practice assertive communication that can be used to interrupt or de-escalate violent situations. 


