

My name is Kyle Johnson, the Las Positas College Student Government President. As some of you may know, the Board of Trustees approved a COVID-19 Vaccine mandate in late August. Our college has worked diligently to bring our students back to campus safely, and that process has been put in place now. In saying that, here is some information you need to know about the process.

For those students who plan to return to campus for in-person instruction in the spring, you must submit your vaccine verification before signing up for in-person courses on <u>CLASS-Web</u>. I wanted to remind you all to please check your <u>Zonemail accounts</u> for information regarding how to submit proof of your COVID-19 Vaccine Verification Card (if you are unable to access Zonemail, please see the link at the bottom of this letter). It takes time to verify your card on the back end of the system, so please do this as soon as possible. You should receive your email to submit the card <u>5-7 days</u> in advance of your Class-Web to allow you to resend the verification link to your Zonemail. To resend the link:

Go into <u>Class-Web</u> Click on <u>Student Services</u> Click on <u>Student records</u> (check holds, transcripts, etc) Click on <u>Check Priority Status</u> In the middle of the page, there will be a line "to Resend CLEARED4 link" Refresh your email and submit your verification card. Please allow for them to verify your records (minimum 48 hours)

*Students who are in the process of getting the COVID-19 Vaccine must have both doses before registering for in-person courses.

Online options will be offered for most courses for those who choose not to vaccinate. You can also apply for <u>a medical or religious exemption</u>, but you cannot register for face-to-face classes or sign up for in-person services until it is approved. You must complete this form and submit the required documentation as soon as you can, as it must be reviewed by the school. <u>http://www.laspositascollege.edu/spring22/exemption.php</u>

I am so excited for this upcoming semester. I know that this is going to be a life long learning adjustment for all of us, but we are strong, capable, and are all in this together, as LPC Hawks!



2020-21 Compared to 2019-20





Changes in LPC Student Populations Fall 2021* Compared to Fall 2020



Fall 2021* Compared to Fall 2020



Gender of LPC Students: Fall 1994 to Fall 2021(preliminary)




Headcount of LPC Students: Fall 1994 to Fall 2021(preliminary)




Race-Ethnicity Fall 2000 vs. Fall 2021


