Introduction of New Climate Action

- There are two new District fellows, Meghan Pletch and Katie Dickson
- While the two fellows are each assigned a campus, they will collaborate on transportation admissions and waste over the next year
- The fellows are employees of SCI
- Meghan Pletsch assigned to LPC is a recent graduate of UC Berkeley, where she worked on their waste research team and has experience with a nonprofit on their environmental data
- Katie Dickinson, assigned to Chabot, is a graduate of Northern Arizona University with a Master Degree in Climate Science and Solutions
- The team will hire six student interns to work alongside them on energy-related projects and Atlas
- Jenny Low from SCI will assist with onboarding Meghan and Katie
- Locating funding sources for the internships is underway; the team is writing a proposal to the Foundation for a \$4000-\$7000 donation
- Once the internship job description is available, Meghan will send it out to all Department Deans for distribution

Campus Drone Survey Update

- Professor Cearley provide the committee with an update on his drone project
- He shared footage of the LPC Vineyard starting in July through October, showing the growth pattern, progression into hibernation, and eventual blossoming in the spring
- Other drone projects include thermal imaging, work with M&O, and an AG survey
- Before each survey, flight plans are submitted to Campus Safety
- The work completed during the fall semester is leading up to a drone program launch in Fall 2022

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- The committee agreed to support Professor Cearley's drone program request with the caveat of creating a campus-wide notification system similar to constructions notices
- Board policies may eventually require implementation
