# **Getting to Livermore from the Airport**

There are 3 major airports nearby:

- San Francisco International Airport (SFO) www.flysfo.com
- Oakland International Airport (OAK) www.oaklandairport.com
- Mineta San José International (SJC) www.sjc.org and

Oakland is the closest international airport to Livermore, but San Francisco International is a bigger airport so there are the most flights here. Unfortunately, we cannot meet you at the airport. However, there are several ways to get from the airport to the place you are staying in the Tri-Valley Area including by public transportation, airport shuttle, and by taxi.

### • Public Transportation

You can travel by train by taking the Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) to locations throughout the Bay Area. BART is available from the Oakland and San Francisco Airports, with a station inside the San Francisco International Airport terminal. From the San Francisco International Airport station, board BART on a Dublin/Pleasanton bound train. Get off at the end of the line at the Dublin/Pleasanton station. The cost is \$11.60 one way. From here, you can take a taxi to the place you are staying or take the Wheels bus #12 directly to Las Positas College. #### Taxis

Taxis are readily available, but the fares are high. All taxis are required by Airport regulation to accept fares to all Bay Area destinations. The cost can be lowered by sharing the taxi with up to 4 other passengers. It costs approximately \$161 from SFO to Livermore.

### **Living in Livermore**

#### Climate

Located 69 kilometers (43 miles) South East of San Francisco and further inland, Livermore has an average temperature of 15 degrees Centigrade. In the summer, there is often fog in the morning and evening so it is a good idea to dress in layers of clothing that you can put on and take off easily. A T-shirt is usually enough for the afternoon, but you may need a sweatshirt or sweater for the morning. It rains a lot in the winter so bring some good rain clothes and shoes.

#### **Health Insurance**

Medical care in the United States is extremely costly (it can cost \$2,000 to \$3,000 per day in the hospital) so most people have health insurance to help cover the costs. This is why health insurance is required to enroll in our school. You should buy a policy that covers all medical and hospital costs and provides a deductible of \$100 or less and covers at least 75% of hospital and insurance costs. Your plan must also include repatriation and medical evacuation. You may be able to purchase health insurance in your country that covers medical expenses while in the U.S. You must present evidence of continuous medical insurance coverage to the International Student Program Office before the end of the second week of classes. Failure to do so may result in dismissal from the college. Please see the International Program Office staff who can recommend some good and inexpensive plans designed especially for International Students.

# Important Things to take with you to the U.S.A.

Bring with you to the United States any important documents that relate to your immigration, travel, legal, academic, and medical history: Passport, identification cards, driver's licenses, etc. If possible, obtain English translations of these documents and have the translations certified by a U.S. educational advising center at the U.S. Embassy or Consulate. Retain photocopies of all original documents for your records.

- Marriage certificate, birth certificate (for you and your dependents if applicable)
- Medical and dental records, including certificates of Immunizations and vaccinations (especially rubella, rubella and tuberculin for you and young children.
- Proof of health insurance coverage in the United States (if you have coverage)
- Information about medical conditions or treatments and prescriptions for medication (generic and name brands)
- Official transcripts from secondary (high schools), colleges and universities you have attended
- Driver's License and International Driver's License if you plan on driving in the U.S.
- Any other copies of immigration and travel documents from the past
- A good bilingual dictionary
- Souvenirs and photos from your home to share with your new friends
- Traditional clothes that you can proudly display at our annual International Night celebration

#### Orientation

Please report to the International Student Program Office in Building #1600 on the campus of Las Positas College. The college address is 3033 Collier Canyon Road, Livermore, CA 94551.
