

- Measure progress of new degree-seeking students
- New degree-seeking student:
 - First time in college and in first 3 years:
 - Earned 6 units
 - Took any English or Math course

- New student cohorts followed for 6 years
 - Latest cohort is 2008-09 thru 2013-14
- Cohorts are divided into two groups:
 - College-prepared:
 - Started English at college level AND
 - Math at AA/AS degree level
 - Unprepared for college (our Basic Skills students)
 - Started English below college level OR
 - Math below degree level.



Number of new degree-seeking students in College-prepared and Basic Skills groups




- Progress outcomes

 - Or earned an AA/AS Degree or Certificate


Percentage Persisting for 3 semesters College-prepared and Basic Skills groups



Percentage Earning 30 units in 6 years College-prepared and Basic Skills groups




Percentage Completing in 6 years College-prepared and Basic Skills groups




Outcomes for 2008-09 Cohort after 6 years College-prepared and Basic Skills groups




Number of new degree-seeking students in College-prepared and Basic Skills groups




Percentage Persisting for 3 semesters College-prepared and Basic Skills groups



Percentage Earning 30 units in 6 years College-prepared and Basic Skills groups




Percentage Completing in 6 years College-prepared and Basic Skills groups
