Placement Methods Before F16

- The majority of students were placed into English and math using only one measure, the Accuplacer test (a standardized test).
- For students whose Accuplacer scores were on the border or who appealed their placement, other measures would be considered.
- So in the past, we have only used multiple measures to place a small number of students.
- Ed code requires the use of multiple measures in college placement.

Placement Method Starting F16

- Almost all students were placed using both Accuplacer scores and high school GPA.
- The placement was based on whichever measure was stronger.
- GPA is 2.5 or higher
- From an American high school, during the last ten years
- Self-report
- Spot checks

Results

- Instructors are not seeing a change in 1A students
 - Karin will add survey findings
 - Success rates did not fall
 - Student who placed by GPA only had comparable success rates to other students
- Small drop in Basic Skills success rates, as expected

Next Steps

- Continuing to measure success
 - Future 1As
 - English 4 and 7
- Working to get our district high schools to upload data to CalPASS so we don't have to rely on self-report, even though studies have self report to be reliable.
 - Transparency

Impact of the New Multiple Measure Criterion (High School GPA of at least 2.50) on English 1A Success Rates





2015 Vs. 2016






Las Positas College Overall English 1A Success Rates Fall 2012 Through Fall 2016





Fall 2012 to Fall 2016




