ANTICIPATED POWER OUTAGE UPDATE

The reason for the power outage is to replace the electrical switchgear that provides electricity to the entire campus. It is anticipated that Buildings 100, 1600, and 1700 (partial list) will have electricity but may operate with no air conditioning for approximately one week.
