COMMON ASSESSMENT INITIATIVE UPDATE

In October 2017, the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office announced that the creation of a common assessment instrument to be used by all California community colleges would be suspended indefinitely as a result of the state legislative mandate to implement multiple measures. Thankfully, Las Positas College has been proactive in implementing multiple measures in English and mathematics. Initial results from English for the past year are promising and we look forward to receiving similar results from the implementation of multiple measures in mathematics that began last month.

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT UPDATE

Effective spring 2018, concurrently enrolled students including those enrolled in Middle College will no longer be able to register in Kinesiology or Physical Education courses. The rationale behind this decision is that individual Kinesiology or Physical Education class or course section may not have concurrent enrollment that exceeds ten percent per California Education Code 76002(a)(4). Apportionment for concurrent enrollees may not be claimed for courses that exceed the limitation. Middle College officials have been informed of the change and options are being explored to help students meet high school graduation requirements.

BEHAVIORAL INTERVENTION RESOURCE TEAM

The Behavioral Intervention Resource Team (BIRT) at Las Positas College was formed to record, assist, and respond to referrals of students who require mental health services or intervention. Stress, sleep disorders, depression, anxiety, and seasonal affect disorder have been on the rise especially for traditional college aged students (18 to 25 years old). Please report any student mental health concern to your immediate supervisor, Campus Safety & Security, or the Student Health & Wellness Center depending on the severity and day and time of the referral. DELAYED IMPLEMENTATION OF DEGREE WORKS

Although the implementation of Degree Works was delayed it did not mean that work on the initiative stalled. In fact, under the leadership of Dean Sylvia Rodriguez and Jesus Bravo-Morales, Degree Works is about to launch any day now. A new webpage is being developed to introduce the initiative to colleagues and students alike. Degree Works will allow students to learn of degree requirements, consider "what if scenarios" if they change majors, and determine how much time it will take them to graduate. Las Positas College is very excited about this initiative since it will put information at the fingertips of students.

FASTPASS EVENT

Las Positas College will be hosting a FastPass event from Monday, November 27th through Wednesday, November 29th from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. to help prospective students navigate the matriculation process from admission application through course registration. Attendees will have the opportunity to complete the online orientation, assessment testing, student educational plans, and financial aid application. All sessions will be available all three days on a first-come, first-served basis. All activities will take place in the Student Services & Administration Building.
