PLANS FOR DSPS

Las Positas College is currently in the process of hiring a new Director of Disabled Student Programs & Services (DSPS). The position closed on Friday, August 30, 2019 and if all goes as planned with the recruitment, we plan to welcome our new Director in January 2020. In addition, Las Positas College plans to initiate a recruitment for a full-time DSPS Counselor in December 2019. If all goes as planned with the recruitment, we plan to welcome our new DSPS Counselor in fall semester 2020. In the meantime, the DSPS program will continue to rely upon the expertise of our Classified Professionals and part-time Counselors, along with the help of Heike Gecox, Counselor/Instructor, who has played an instrumental role in helping serve our disabled students and colleagues alike.

RESTROOM UPDATE

Many colleagues have asked about the status of the single stall restrooms within the Student Services & Administration Building, Building 1600. Working in collaboration with our Project Planner/Manager and the Maintenance & Operations Department, the single stall restrooms are being relabeled to more accurately reflect their multiuse by diverse students, colleagues, and the public. The single stall restroom on the second floor of the building will remain a "staff only" restroom. We also acknowledge that the door locking mechanisms that were recently replaced are less than ideal and we are working to address this concern.
